

In the clues, "A" means across and "D" means down. For example, "4-D" would refer to clue number 4 DOWN.

Each square takes a single digit from 0 through 9. No answer begins with 0.

10. Jarrett works at the Deluxe Ice Cream Parlor, where double-dip cones are sold, as well as bulk ice cream packed in pints, quarts, or half-gallons. Last Wednesday, a particularly warm day, 241 cartons of bulk ice cream were sold, of which there were more pints than half-gallons, and there were almost exactly twice as many quarts as half-gallons.

Jarrett's Great-aunt Martha was charged the full price of \$9.66 when she bought a carton of each of the three sizes of bulk ice cream. The price of the quart is just under $1\frac{3}{4}$ times the price of the pint, while the price of the half-gallon is 10¢ – 15¢ less than $3\frac{1}{2}$ times the price of the quart.

All money answers in the puzzle are in cents.
