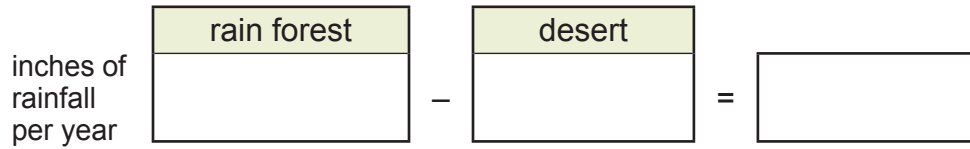


2. On average, how many more inches of rain fall in the rain forest than in the desert annually?

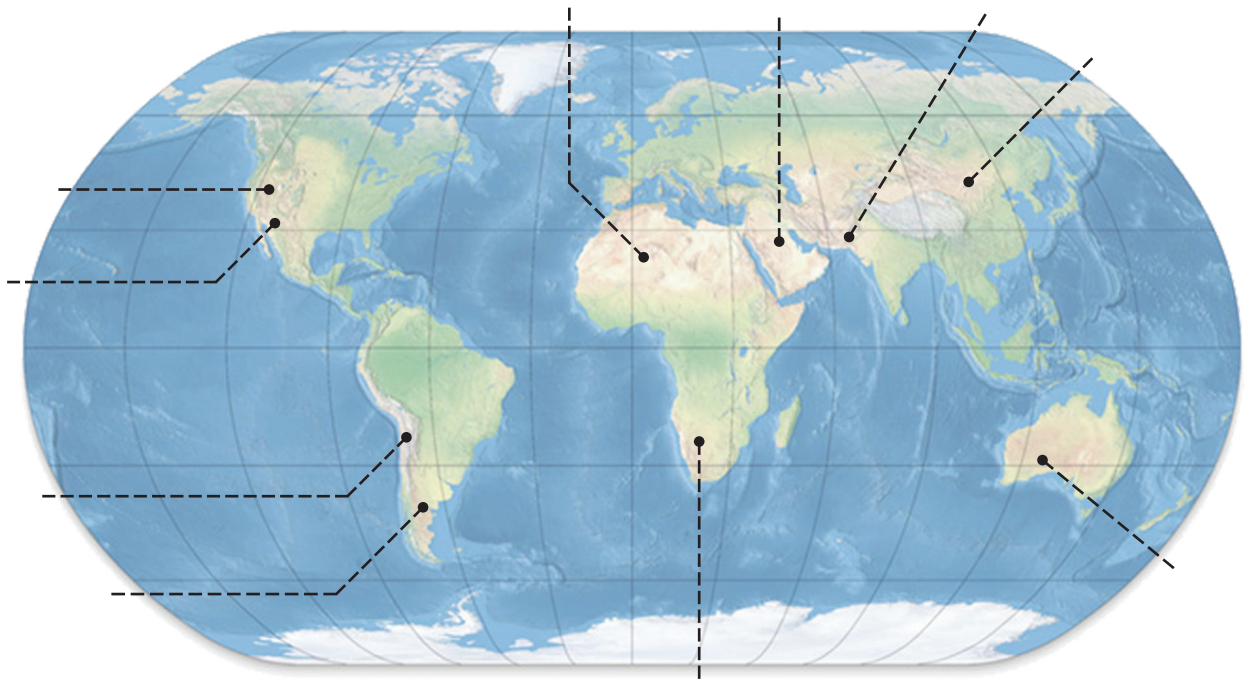
4. Deserts are usually found between which lines of latitude?
